Churches

Christian congregations

Consumed

Engulfed; Eaten

Death

The point at which a person ceases to live.

Doves

Birds known by their white feathers; A symbol of the Holy Spirit at Jesus' baptism

Eternal

Timeless; existing outside of time

God

His name in Hebrew is YHVH, often pronounced as Yahweh or Jehovah; Only deity worshiped by the Israelites; Main person of the Godhead in the Trinity

Hailstones

Pieces of ice that fall from clouds during some storms

Haman

In the book of Esther, antagonist who attempted to wipe out Hebrew population

High Priest

All priests were descendants of Aaron when God created the priesthood and chosen by God to serve man in all things pertaining to God that he might offer both gifts and sacrifices for sins (see Hebrews 5:1) The High Priest was the only one who could go behind the curtain that separated the holy of Holies from the holy place in the temple. He could only do that one time per year and he had to follow strict guidelines while in there.

Life

Existence on the physical or spiritual level

Moses Staff

A rod that Moses used to perform miracles, including parting the Red Sea (See Exodus 14:21-22), the plague of turning all the water in Egypt to blood (not affecting the Israelites, See Exodus 7:14-24), and having water gush from a stone in the 40 year trek in the desert (See Exodus 17:1-7)

Nazareth

A city where Jesus lived; A city with a poor reputation

Officials

Designated figures of authority in government

Paradise

Used metaphorically three times in the New Testament and describes the place where the spirits of God's people go when the die. Luke 23:43, 2 Corinthians 12:3-4 and Revelation 2:7

Pharisees

A Jewish sect in Jesus' time who believed to gain acceptance by God was to live separately from the societal norm. Typically a name of one who thinks too highly of oneself.
