Cornerstone

A key block of a building which helps to align the measurements and direction of a structure; Christ is usually referred to as the cornerstone of the church.

Grave

Serious; A place where a body is laid to rest; Death; The place of the dead; Sometimes translated from the Hebrew word "Sheol", a place described in much of Ecclesiastes and may be translated as "Hell" in some versions of the Bible

Heir

The next in line to a throne or in equal to a ruler or king. Christians are often referred to this with Jesus in God's riches.

Just

In Scripture this is a trait synonymous with honourable and fair

Moab

A kingdom near the Dead Sea

Obstinate

Sticking to an opinion despite all evidence to the contrary; Difficult to fix or get under control

Persisted

To have continued in something; To have not given up

Priest

A Jewish office. A person who would intercede on behalf of the people before God and would represent God before the people.

Pure

Refuge

Slaughtering

W weapon made from a long shaft with a sharp point at one end; A common strategy in ancient warfare was for soldiers to form a wall of shields while holding spears forward to fight off oncoming charges

Threshing Floor

A large, flat surface in which harvested grain would be gathered and the edible parts of the grain would be separated from the inedible parts and pests

Thwart

To avoid happening

Tithe

A portion of one's earnings given to God, usually to his workers (in Hebraic sense, it would have been the Levites; in today's context, usually means the church).
