Affliction

Great pain or suffering; A cause of pain and suffering

Bidding

One's wish, demand or desire

Christ

A reference to Jesus, from a Greek word meaning "Anointed"

Conduct

A person's behavior; To lead; To behave

God

His name in Hebrew is YHVH, often pronounced as Yahweh or Jehovah; Only deity worshiped by the Israelites; Main person of the Godhead in the Trinity

Habits

Things that are done as a routine, often without giving a second thought

Harlot

A female prostitute

Hungry

Experiencing hunger

Idolatry

The act of primarily worship something or someone in place of God.

Just

In Scripture this is a trait synonymous with honourable and fair

Lamb

A baby sheep, often used in sacrifices under the old covenant; A term used to refer to Jesus if capitalized

Lame

Unable to walk; Jesus healed a paralyzed man (See Mark 2:1-12)

Money

Something of value that is used for trade or exchange, often made by a governing body

New Testament

The last 27 books of the Bible; The new covenant initiated by Jesus dying on the cross

Potter

A person who makes pottery

Precepts

Commands; Orders; Instruction

Race

A people with the same origins, nationality, or ethnicity; A competition

Shaddai

A word used in the Hebrew phrase El Shaddai, translated as "God Almighty"

Success

Achievement of a desired outcome

Sustain

To keep something operating or living
