Accused

Having been declared guilty of a crime, sin, or wrongdoing; People who have been declared guilty of a crime, sin, or wrongdoing

Briars

Small plants that have a woody and thorny stem

Churches

Christian congregations

Compel

To force or manipulate someone into doing something; To drive someone to take a certain course of action

Decree

An order that is treated as law, usually given by kings, emperors, or judges (See Luke 2:1-7)

Devours

Eating greedily; Consuming quickly

Eternal Security

A doctrine that states that once a person is saved he/she can not lose salvation

Fear

state of avoiding or not wanting to face something or someone.

Fooled

To have deceived or tricked someone; To have been deceived or tricked by someone

Freed

To have been liberated; To have been loosed from slavery or imprisonment

A king who was almost convinced by Paul to become a Christian (See Acts 26)

Loathe

To despise; To greatly dislike

Model

One who exemplifies certain qualities for another

Overcome

To prevail; To not let an obstacle get the best of you and get past it

Pagan

A person who practices a polytheistic religion; A word used to describe things related to a polytheistic religion

Parousia

Refers to the arrival of someone of high rank. Example: Acts 1:11

Wound

Damage done to living tissue; To inflict such an injury
