Altar

A structure in which an offering or sacrifice is made upon.

Budget

The amount of money allotted for everything a person, group, or organization needs

Convictions

Beliefs or values that a person lives by

Diligence

Constant attention; Haste

Faltered

Stumbled

God

His name in Hebrew is YHVH, often pronounced as Yahweh or Jehovah; Only deity worshiped by the Israelites; Main person of the Godhead in the Trinity

Grace

The force by which God extends to all persons so that they may choose to live under his leadership.

Helmet

A piece of armor worn on the head

Horn

An instrument that is blown to play music or to give a signal, often to an army

Julius

Centurion (i.e. Roman soldier) who transported Paul to Rome (See Acts 27:1-3)

Master

The person or thing a person devotes primary importance to; the person/thing which rules over a person.

Prodigal Son

Main character in one of Jesus' parables who runs away from home with his inheritance, squanders it, and then returns to his father thinking he will become a slave. But instead he is welcomed back with open arms by his father who celebrates his return. See Luke 15:11-32

Prophecy

A statement made from God through a prophet. Usually associated with predictions of future events.

Ship

A large vessel built for navigating large bodies of water

Teaches

Instructing; Passing on knowledge

Teaching

Instructing; Passing on knowledge; A doctrine; An idea that is passed from one person to another

Terror

Extreme fright; Horror

Uprightness

Moral goodness

Wasteland

Any land that is lifeless or desolate

Zealot

A fanatical follower of a Jewish sect that was militantly hostile to Roman rule

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
